IEE launches Single Person Detector and People Counter at Passenger Terminal Expo in London

Luxembourg, 20th March 2009 – IEE, the internationally renowned Luxembourg sensing specialist, presents its airport safety sensing systems at Passenger Terminal Expo, which takes place from 24th – 26th 2009 March in London's (ExCel Exhibition Centre, IEE stand: 2000).

IEE's People Counter counts the exact number of people in a given area and provides data on the number of people who entered and left and their dwelling time. The Single Person Detector can be implemented for automated border controls or check-in procedures, where only one person at a time can enter the area for document verification. By integrating seamlessly into existing access control systems, IEE's sensing solutions reduce staff costs and increase the overall efficiency of building and access security.

The technology is based on the company's 3D MLI (Modulated Light Intensity) Sensor and uses modulated infrared light to obtain a 3D image of the monitored area. The sensor offers reliable data output even in challenging light or temperature conditions; it provides extremely low false-alarm rates and is very reliable in comparison to other technologies on the market.
