

IEE to present award-winning Tailgate Detector TDflex, People Counter and Volumetric Object Surveillor at IFSEC in Birmingham

Luxembourg, May 6th, 2011 – Luxembourg-based sensing specialist IEE will hold live demonstrations of its Tailgate Detector TDflex, People Counter and Volumetric Object Surveillor at this year's IFSEC, which is taking place in Birmingham from 16-19 May (IEE booth: 4/B150).

The enhanced design housing of the People Counter as well as a premiering demo of the Volumetric Object Surveillor will be presented at the IFSEC for the first time ever. Visitors can also participate in a demo of the Tailgate Detector TDflex, an access control solution that has been awarded several prizes over the past year due to its innovative features. TDflex is also one of the finalists in this year's IFSEC Security Industry Award for Access Control Product of the Year.

Award-Winning Tailgate Detector TDflex

Typically mounted above secured access points such as doors and turnstiles, TDflex provides an additional security layer to access control systems. The sensor intercepts the signal emitted from an ID reader (badge system, RFID, biometrics), establishes whether a single individual is attempting entry, and detects their direction of movement. In the event of dual or unauthorized entry, TDflex triggers an alarm or blocks access points. The Tailgate Detector offers an enhanced accuracy solution compared to laser- or video-based products currently on the market.

TDflex has received four awards over the past year (Security Innovation Award at the Security Essen 2010, GSN Homeland Security Award 2010, Fedil's Innovation prize 2010, and Best Access Control Product Award at ISC West 2011), and is shortlisted to receive the IFSEC Security Industry Award for Best Access Control Product. TDflex is in competition with five other pioneering inventions in the category access control and biometrics.

Premiere of Next Generation People Counter with Optimized Design

IEE's People Counter provides real-time data on the number of people moving through a specific detection area, and can be used for occupancy monitoring and analysis applications. The People Counter holds an unprecedented accuracy rate exceeding 99%, and allows for historic data analysis, data aggregation and time plotting, permitting precise calculations such as the average time an individual spends inside a particular zone. The new enhanced design of the People Counter will be premiering at the IFSEC, presenting a lighter, easier to integrate and smarter new housing look. IEE will also allow a first glimpse of its newly developed software which further simplifies the installation and offers enhanced user-friendliness.

Premiere of Volumetric Object Surveillor

The Volumetric Object Surveillor aids in protecting objects by monitoring the volume around any given item and detecting intrusion into a specified surveillance area. The audio and visual alarms are configured for increasing threat levels depending on proximity of the intruder, and the sensor triggers a direct and immediate warning in the event that the surveillance area is compromised. The VOS will be demonstrated at IFSEC for the first time ever, and visitors will have the chance to test the system and its alarm levels live at the IEE booth.
